#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Kyle Hoylman called meeting to order at 3:05pm.

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

• Steve Rice motioned to approve August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024, meeting minutes. Kyle Hoylman second. Motion carried.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Review of optional background checks.
  - Reviewed options of Administrative Office of Courts (AOC), Kentucky State Police (KSP), and Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI).
    - KSP includes notes on sex offender registry.
    - Board Administrator to follow up with AOC if they include sex offender registry. Follow up on KSP and AOC cost.
- Administrative Regulations review
  - o Certifications items to be submitted to show up to date with trainings.
    - o EPA
    - o NBRS
  - Insurance is under statute, which would require being reopened through legislative process.
  - o Radon contractor wording will require opening statute through legislation to edit.
  - o Renewal time frame to be every two years to match NBRS and EPA.
  - o Background check to be completed every two years along with renewal.
  - o Payments for DPL are made to the Kentucky State Treasure.
  - o Removal of inactive registration status No need.

- Review of CEU requirements. EPA and NBRS certification would be proof of upto-date trainings.
- O Data reports to be submitted annually.
- o Radon measurement/Lab analysis needs to know who conducts the analysis.
- Continued review of Illinois Regulations
  - O Data/Records keeping / Retention of records.
  - O Water measurement / Water mitigation.
  - Board to reach out to Illinois about large businesses/schools for feedback & possible changes.
